## TROPHIES

Please note only fully paid up members of EWPCA will be allowed to take trophies. This ruling has been introduced to prevent the disappearance or late return of trophies.

## WORLD HORSE WELFARE EQUESTRIAN CENTRE REQUEST:

- **Equine Influenza. All horses that visit this farm must be vaccinated within the last 6 months but not within the last 7 days of the visit. The completed declaration is to be given to the Show Secretary along with the passport(s) for checking when you collect your numbers and before you unload your animals. This applies to all pre-entries and on the day entries.**
- Gateways/walkways are not to be obstructed.
- Ponies and cobs must not be left unattended whilst tied to the side of lorries and trailers.
- Dogs must be kept on leads and supervised at all times.
- Dogs are not permitted to run loose in the parking field.
- Dogs are not permitted in the warm up arena, collecting ring or competition arenas for the duration of the event.
- No mucking out lorries in the car park.
- Please place rubbish in the bins provided.
- No balls.
- Smoking. There is one designated smoking area. The designated smoking area is located in the visitor car park, on the path next to the gates, leading down to the outdoor school. Smoking is Strictly Prohibited in all other areas.
- It is the individual's responsibility to unload and load their horse(s) safely and effectively. Individuals must wear suitable footwear and headwear (in accordance with current BHS standards) at all times when unloading/loading their horse(s).
- Children must be under the immediate control and supervision of an adult at all times. Children MUST NOT be left unsupervised at Hall Farm. This includes in the visitor centre, indoor play area and outdoor play area.
- Exercising horses in the parking field is strictly prohibited at all times.

## EWPCA/WPCS RULES

**Exhibitors, owners and producers are expected to be familiar with the rules of the Show and the WPCS. A copy of WPCS Rules is held by Show Secretary.**

*Those below are to be read and agreed prior to entry.*

1. It is strongly recommended that competitors hold adequate third party insurance cover in respect of any accident caused by themselves, their family or helpers, their vehicles or

animals when on the showground. All In-Hand exhibits must be registered with WPCS with exception of classes 1 and 2.

2. EWPCA reserve the right to alter classes or judges without notice.
3. EWPCA accepts no responsibility for any loss or damage.
4. The Judge's decision is final in all cases.
5. Manes and tails must not be plaited with the exception of an optional single plait behind the ear for Sections A, B, C and D. Welsh Part-bred animals should be plaited. However this is optional, as it would be normal for 'traditional and native' type Part-breds to be shown with a full mane and tail.
6. Animals, 3-years-old and under must not be body clipped for showing purposes. It is permissible for hair under the jaw line, round the muzzle and protruding from the ears to be trimmed. Medals will not be awarded to clipped animals (3-years and under) and the Society can revoke an award if an animal is later found to have been clipped.
7. Animals, 4-years-old or over, which have been clipped for winter activities can be shown and should not be penalised. Judges must take special note of this. Legs must not be clipped. It is permissible for hair under the jaw line, round the muzzle and protruding from the ears to be trimmed. Fresh clipping for spring shows is not permissible.
8. If the mane and tail are very thick, they can be discreetly thinned to show off the top line and the hindquarters. The tail should look natural and should not be "banged" (levelled off square). Artificial changes to the original markings of an animal as recorded on the Passport will not be allowed, nor the addition of false manes and tails.
9. All stallions exhibited in stallion classes must be in possession of a Welsh Pony and Cob Society Licence of Correctness (or acknowledged alternative).
10. In the interest of safety all colts and stallions, two-years-old or over must be suitably bitted and led by a handler who has reached the age of 14-years or over before January 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year. For colts/stallions the use of stallion show tack is optional.
11. Youngstock may be shown in a white webbing or rope show halter, leather head collar or show bridle (excluding 2 and 3-year-old colts, see rule 10).
12. Mares/geldings, 4-years-old or over, may be shown in a white webbing or rope show halter, leather head collar, show bridle or riding bridle.
13. No exhibitor should leave the ring unless permission has been obtained from the Judge *via* the Steward. The class ends when the Judge requests the class to be dismissed.
14. Substitution of handlers in Welsh classes is not permitted without the permission of the Judge.
15. A courteous manner is expected at all times. Exhibitors should conduct themselves at all times in an orderly, polite manner as they represent the Welsh breeds and consequently the WPCS. Bad language is not tolerated under any circumstances whether to fellow exhibitors, owners, producers, judges, stewards or show officials. Bad behaviour brings the Society into disrepute.
16. It is the exhibitors' responsibility to ensure they are in the ring at the right time and should not expect a show or its judges to hold up a class for them.
17. Exhibitors should be dressed neatly and circumspectly. A judge is empowered to ask an exhibitor to leave the ring if considered inappropriately dressed. Denim is not acceptable. Exhibitors must not wear clothing displaying any form of advertising.
18. Exhibitors should ensure they are wearing the correct number for the animal they are showing.

19. All ridden ponies must be 4-years-old or over and registered in the Pure Bred section of their Mountain and Moorland Breed Society's Stud Book or in the Part-Bred section of WPCS.
20. Juniors who have not attained their 12<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year may not ride small breed stallions. See BSPS Rule 317 for BPS classes.
21. Juniors who have not attained their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year may not ride large breed stallions. See BPS Rule 318 for BPS classes.
22. Hard hats, to approved current BSI Standard, to be worn and correctly secured at all times when mounted. Spurs/dress spurs not to be worn.
23. The shaft of a whip or cane must not exceed 75 cm (30 inches). In Lead Rein classes plain or leather covered canes ONLY may be used.
24. In First Ridden classes ponies must not be cantered except in their individual show.
25. Anyone causing a disturbance, of any kind, will be asked to leave the showground, forfeiting all entry fees.
26. Objections must be made in writing within 15 minutes of the finish of the class accompanied by a deposit of £15.00.

**WELSH PONY AND COB GELDING INCENTIVE SCHEME** – Overall Gelding Champion and Reserve to be competed for by the highest placed geldings from each appropriate section within Sections A, B, C and D. Generously sponsored by the Millcroft Stud.

**NPS: This show is a qualifier for the NPS Summer Championship Show – 31<sup>st</sup> July – 2<sup>nd</sup> August 2020.**

**NPS Qualifying Rounds:** All NPS ridden classes at this show are run under these rules. These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain and Moorland Stud Books. Part-breds are not eligible for Mountain and Moorland Classes.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS **Qualifying or Life** members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at the Royal Three Counties Showground, Malvern from 31<sup>st</sup> July – 2<sup>nd</sup> August 2020.

The highest placed pony, if owned by a NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

The in hand classes at this show are run under breed show rules.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members and at Breed Shows ponies can qualify for the final even if their owners are not NPS members. The owner of a pony qualifying at a Breed Show must become an NPS Qualifying member for the pony to enter the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. At Breed Shows ponies can win Silver Medal Rosettes even if their owners are not members of the NPS but they must become NPS Qualifying members to enter the final.

NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated.

## **NPS Picton Novice Classes 34, 35, 36, 37 and 38.**

Open to pure bred registered M&M stallions, mares and geldings 4-years-old or over.

A pony is not eligible to compete if, before 1st January in the current year, it has done any of the following:

- i. Won an open affiliated mixed M&M Ridden class.
- ii. Qualified for Horse of the Year Show, Olympia or RIHS Open M&M Ridden classes.
- iii. Qualified for the M&M Novice or Intermediate Ridden final at the NPS Summer Championship show (N.B. Ponies can compete as novices in this competition for two consecutive years provided they do not submit an entry to the final in the first year).
- iv. If a pony qualifies for Horse of the Year Show, Olympia or RIHS in its second year it is immediately de-noviced and cannot compete in the Picton Final.
- v. Ponies must be shown in a snaffle bit.

## **BSPS**

**This show is affiliated to BSPS and is a qualifier for the BSPS Summer Championship Show to be held at Arena UK on 26<sup>th</sup> - 29<sup>th</sup> August, 2020, including the BSPS Best Rider and BSPS Classic Services Group Challenge. The Binks Family Champions of Champions, 1<sup>st</sup> prize winners in classes 40 – 46 will qualify.**

- No pony shall be shown on a leading rein except those entered in Leading Rein classes.
- In all Heritage classes, ponies are restricted to the height limits laid down by their appropriate Breed Societies.
- The Ponies' Breed Society Registration Numbers **MUST** be stated when entering Heritage Classes.
- Judges will penalise ponies that have been excessively clipped or trimmed.
- All other BSPS General Rules are applicable.

**TSR NAF Five Star Showing Finals** - This show is a qualifier for the 2020 TSR NAF Five Star Showing Finals. Qualify and enter ANY of the Finals Central, East Anglia, North West, North East, South East, South, Wales and South West or Scottish. You Do Not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals!

**TSR NAF Five Star Riders Finals** - 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> riders qualify and will receive a qualification flyer in the ring.

**TSR NAF Five Star In Hand Finals** - The two highest placed Handlers with a TSR In Hand sheet will qualify in any In Hand class. Handlers **MUST** have their sheet signed in the ring by the judge/steward, cards are available **FREE** from the TSR website. Full details at <http://www.theshowingregister.co.uk>.

**Equifest and BSHA Intro Championships** - With a TSR qualification flyer you can also enter Equifest 19<sup>th</sup> - 22<sup>nd</sup> August at Peterborough [www.equifest.org.uk](http://www.equifest.org.uk) and the BSHA Intro Champs in September at Addington Equestrian Centre - You do not have to be a BSHA member to qualify or enter the final. **TSR Medal Awards** - TSR members can collect qualification cards and signatures and redeem for a TSR Medal see TSR website for details.

**BSHA Grass Roots Championships** - With a TSR qualification flyer you can also enter the BSHA Grass Roots Champs on the 9<sup>th</sup> September at Addington Equestrian Centre - You do not have to be a BSHA member to qualify or enter the final. See <http://www.britishshowhorse.org>.
